Kevin Wright is a retired U.S. Army Lieutenant Colonel with over 24 years' service with a focus on training, doctrine, and operations. He has extensive instructional experience since military retirement in 2007, as adjunct faculty at Columbus State University, Perimeter College of Georgia State University, Georgia Military College, Keiser University-Tampa Florida Campus and was an online professor of American Government for Arizona State University Global Campus.
